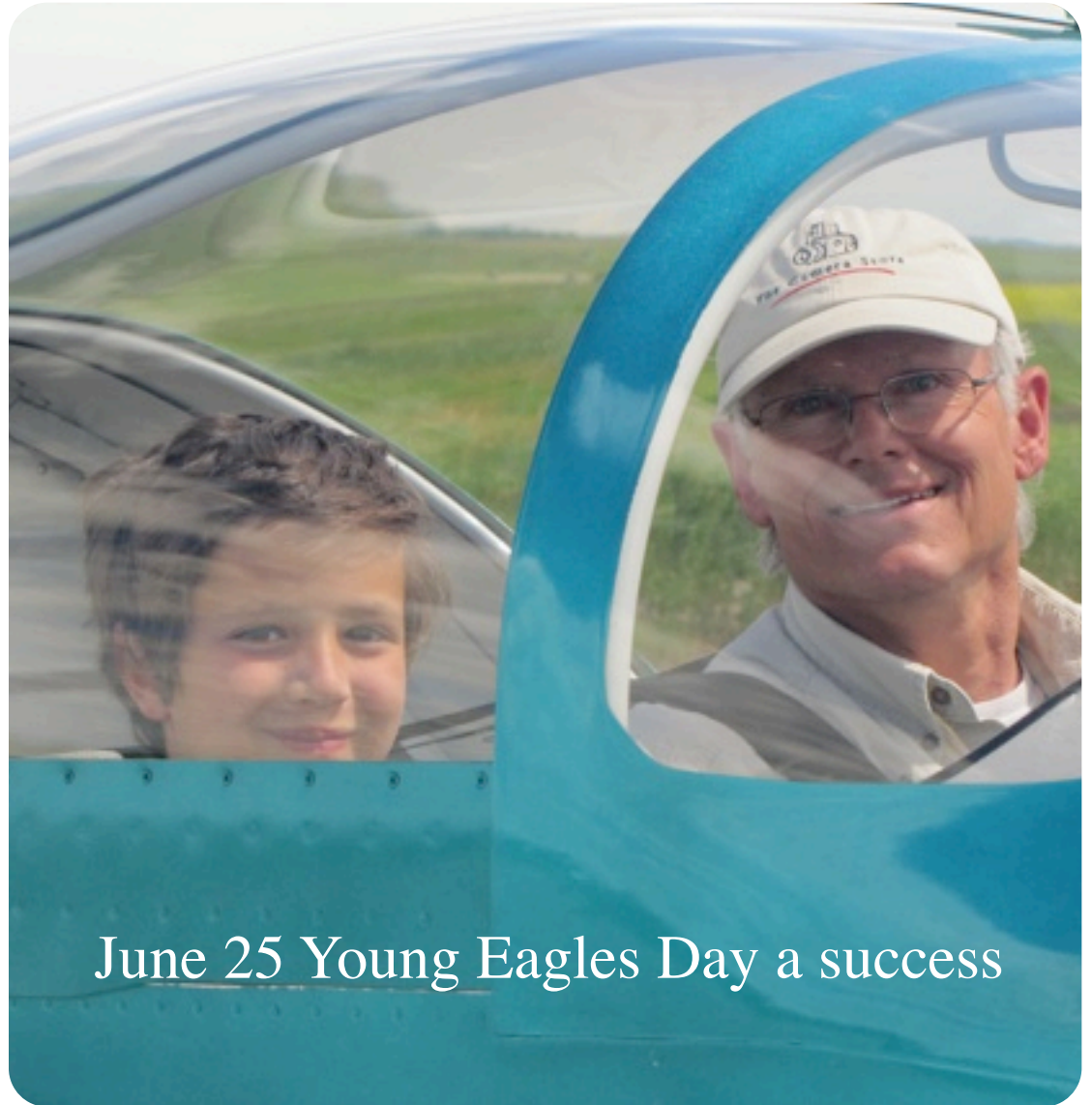

**June 27, 2011** – Hugues Duval broke his own world speed record for an electric aircraft, flying his electric Cri-Cri MC15E E-Cristaline to a speed of 152.7 knots (262 kph) at the Paris Air Show on Saturday, June 25. The world's smallest twin-engine airplane is powered by two 25-hp Electravia electric motors powered by a pair of lithium-polymer Kokam batteries, turning two E-PROPS propellers. Electravia claims a 46 percent drag reduction over conventional powerplants thanks to extensive aerodynamic work on the fairings and equating to a 30 percent speed increase.
