
Who We Are

Propeller guru Paul Lipps lost his brief battle with lung cancer in October. Paul's unorthodox ideas led him to look at propellers a little differently than most and to design a prop that defies logic at first glance, with performance numbers that are equally unbelievable. In 2006, the *Phantom* bi-plane, piloted by Tom Aberle, fitted with Paul's four-blade prop, set a new Reno qualifying record of 249.106 and won the Gold Race at an astounding 251.958 mph!
